- Inculcate in the students a sense of mutual respect, universal brotherhood, love and friendship.



The school infrastructure has always been a matter of pride for PRFS and is suitably planned to accommodate learning, leadership development and a balanced curriculum. The school boasts of sprawling 21 acre lush green campus, its clean and serene surroundings with beautiful landscaping and aesthetically designed building adds attraction to the environs of village Khamini, Mathura.

The academic facilities include well equipped modern ICT laboratories with computers for seniors and juniors, separate laboratories for Physics, Chemistry and Biology, a well stocked Library, Art Gallery, Art and Craft Room, Indoor Sports Room, Air Conditioned Day Boarding House, Dance Room, Music Room, Audio Visual cum ICT Room, Amphitheater, and Swimming Pool.









CLASSROOMS

The airy and spacious classrooms are well designed, colourful with plenty of natural light and ventilation.

LIBRARY

The gauge for the progress and civilization of any nation is the quality and the number of books and the number of persons habituated of reading them. Books are one of the best tools for training and upbringing. The school has well stocked and state of art library cum reading serves as a hunt for those who carve for intellectual nourishment. There are two separate Reading Rooms cum Libraries for juniors and seniors. Our library focuses on providing an excellent educational environment. It is equipped with a good extensive collection of

books, CDs/DVDs and periodical subscriptions, which include magazines and newspapers. Resources are being continually added to the existing collection. PRFS is one of the few schools to have separate library for juniors and seniors.

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COMPUTER CENTRE

Small opportunities are often the beginning of great achievements. Knowledge of computers is inculcated in the student's right from the primary section. Well – equipped Computer labs for juniors and seniors separately, have computers of latest configuration and updating of software is given top priority. We believe that a child should be fully equipped with any aspect of computer in the process of learning and confident to face the challenges of the hi-tech world. Well-trained teaching staff as well as technical staff give ample guidance and cater to the needs of the students.

LABORATORIES

The school has fully equipped, well designed and world class separate laboratories for Physics, Chemistry and Biology, Students from Primary classes onwards get hands on practical experience to complement theoretical knowledge.

AUDIO VISUAL CENTRE

State of art AV centre, with the capacity of 100 students is available for workshops, presentations, film shows and other related activities that facilitate interactive learning.

AMPHITHEATRE

Co-curricular activities are the soul of PRFS. To provide right ethos and ambience to creative activities like dramatics, music, dance the school has a magnificent amphitheatre. A gathering of about one thousand can use the theatre.



Sports form an integral part of school curriculum. The school provides facilities for all major games and sports to encourage healthy competitive character building and physical stamina.

The school has a huge sports field with 400 m track, soccer field, cricket pitch, basket ball courts, lawn tennis courts etc. and state of art Indoor Sports Complex.

Children are encouraged to participate in various sports activities at State and National level.

SWIMMING POOL

Students interested in swimming can make use of a modern Swimming Pool. If willing, they can learn it regularly from a expert trainer. A special care is being taken with advanced technology to keep the water of the Swimming Pool clean and free from contamination.

HEALTH CARE

The institution has a well-equipped infirmary under the able supervision of qualified Female Staff Nurse. In the case of any serious illness, every possible effort is being made to inform the concerned guardian at the earliest possible.

DAY BOARDING

The Day Boarding system makes the school unique in character. The system incorporates academics followed by lunch. The day boarding includes a supervised study-session and extra-curricular activities. For lunch, well-balanced and nourishing vegetarian food is served, while maintaining a high standard of hygiene. The Day Boarding activities bring out the creativity, curiosity and the power of imagination in the child. Sports and games include badminton, basketball, cricket, football, swimming, table tennis/tennis and other indoor games.

HOUSE SYSTEM

Each house is headed by a House Captain who is assisted by a Vice-Captain and Prefects. The House Masters and House Tutors oversee the House activities. Points are awarded to students throughout the year for performance in academics, cultural, literary and sports activities. House getting the highest points is adjudged as the best House.

STUDENT COUNCIL

The school has a strong student council which consists of Head Boy, Head Girl, Deputy Head Boy, Deputy Head Girl, Prefects and Ministers. The student appointees are responsible for maintaining discipline and assisting in smooth functioning of school.

PARENT INVOLVEMENT

A child's education can be greatly enhanced by parents' involvement in the classroom and at home. The school encourages involvement of parents in planning, suggesting, developing



and boosting up the functioning of all school activities. Parents, students and teachers are encouraged to send in their feedback regularly. SCHOOL ORGANIZATION

The school is organized in to following classes:

- Pre-primary This includes classes LKG and UKG (age group 3 years to 4 years). The entry age at LKG level is 3 years as on April 1st of the academic session. In these classes children are acquainted with basic skills through activities and play way methods.
- Primary This includes classes I V. The age group is 5 years to 10 years. The minimum age for admission in class 1 is 5 years as on April 1st of the academic year. The subjects taught are English, Hindi, Mathematics, Environmental Science, Information Technology Activities, Art, Music, Dance, Physical Education and Craft.
- Middle This includes classes VI-VIII. The subjects taught in these classes are: English, Hindi, Third Language, Mathematics, Science, Social Science, General Science and Introductory Information Technology. Curriculum as per recommendations of CBSE.
- Secondary This includes classes IX-X. The subjects prescribed are English (Communicative), Hindi (Course A), Mathematics, Social Science, General Science and Introductory Information Technology. Curriculum as per recommendations of CBSE.
- Senior Secondary This includes classes XI-XII. The streams are : Science, Commerce and Humanities. Curriculum as per the guidelines of CBSE.

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ABSENCE

- 1. Students who have been sick should bring a medical certificate from their doctor on joining school.
- 2. Parents should fill up the "Record for non Attendance" for the student is absent from school stating the reasons for absence.
- 3. Students suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class.
 - a. Chicken pox: Till complete falling of the scab
 - b. Cholera: Till the child is completely well
 - c. Measles: Two weeks after the rash disappears
 - d. Mumps: Until the swellings has gone, about one months
 - e. Whooping cough: Six weeks
 - f. Jaundice: Six weeks after recovery
- 4. If the absence exceed 3 days, a written application must be forwarded to the Principal.
- 5. Repeated absence without leave or unexplained absence for more than 30 consecutive days renders the students liable to have his name struck off the rolls. Re-admission may be granted only on payment of a fresh admission fee.
- 6. All students are expected to attend school on the opening day after each of the vacation.
- 7. It is compulsory for student to complete 80% of their attendance in the year to make them eligible to sit for their final examination.
- 8. The percentage, however, could be relaxed on medical grounds, but such students will not be eligible to receive any prizes.

WITHDRAWALS

• One clear calendar month's notice in writing or a month's fee in lieu of such notice must be given before a pupil can be withdrawn.

Transfer certificates will not be issued until all dues of the school are settled.

Student can be asked to leave the school on the following grounds.

- Discipline
- Unsatisfactory progress in work
- A student who fails twice in the same class will not be permitted to continue his / her studies in the school.
- It is always advisable to write to the school about the problems of your ward or for seeking guidance. Your letters / e-mail / will be replied after discussion with the concerned teachers / persons.

EXAMINATION AND EVALUATION

- 1. Class I & II will not have any formal examination. There will be continuous assessment of the child throughout the year. The areas to be assessed are like reading, speaking, handwriting, spelling, writing, grammar, mathematical skill, simple mental mathematics, environment studies, computer, arts and dance. Besides the scholastic areas, the nonscholastic areas to be assessed are discipline, personal hygiene, manners & etiquettes.
- 2. For class III to X will be having two terminal examinations and unit tests.
- 3. There is no provision of re-test on any grounds.


